

2018 Hajj Packing List

Important to have

- 1 pair of comfortable walking shoes
- Men will need one pair of slippers for Eham
- 1 set of Eham & 1 extra set between two people.
- 2 sets Eham (ladies) (carry one set in your hand luggage)
- 5 pairs of clothes/khanzuz (men)**
- 5 pairs of clothes (ladies)**
- Socks (for women as part of their hijab)
- 2-3 chador/abaya (for women)
- 1 bath towel
- Wrist watch (not expensive)
- Personal Medications*
- Flashlight with batteries (can sometimes be shared with others)
- Spray bottle
- Sleeves (for women)
- Personal Dua Books
- Extra pair of glasses (if you have)
- A pair of flip flops (rubber slippers)

Toiletries Toiletries

- Unscented Liquid Soap (for Ghusal of Eham and can be used throughout your Hajj trip)
- Shampoo\Conditioner (for regular showers)
- A small pair of scissors (for taksir)
- Toothpaste and toothbrush
- Washroom water bottle (during travel)
- Toilet Paper (small quantity/available in Makkah and Medina)
- Comb
- Personal Prescription medications
- Feminine hygiene products for women
- Safety pins
- Vaseline or cortisone cream

Luxury items

- 1 small face cloth
- Disinfecting wipes, baby wipes or wet naps
- Lip Protection
- Empty plastic bags
- Face mask/ dust mask (available in Makkah and Madina pharmacies)
- Colored ribbons for suitcase/tags
- Food/snacks/Gatorade or electrolyte powder
- Cell phone (you can buy local cell phone in Madina and Makkah)
- Camera
- Ipad

- Neck pouch with ID Nametag
- Name tag for the luggage
- Wrist band with emergency contact
- Scarf for ID (ladies only)
- 7 Beads on a string (for the tawaf count)
- Salaat items - i.e. travel musallah
- Small Bag to take to the Haram
- Niyyat cards
- Slipper/Shoe bags
- Hajj Guide Books 1, 2 & 3
- Back pack for Arafah\Mina
- Stone bag

*Extra Medications - (If you would like to carry & can also be shared with others)

- Gravol
- Band Aids
- Dextrose Tablets
- Vitamin C
- Imodium
- CYPRO/Zithromax and other antibiotics
- Tylenol, Aspirin, Advil
- Polysporin
- Zantac
- Blistex
- Blister tapes
- Gatorade or Electrolyte Powder

** There are good laundry facilities in Makkah and Madina, closer to the peak Hajj time Laundromats get very busy. In such cases extra pairs of clothes come in handy. Some hotels have conveniences to hang hand washed clothing (if need be). It would be a good idea to carry a small pack of detergent. Detergents are also available for purchase in Makkah and Madina.
(Washing your own clothes is recommended only for emergency situations.)

Important Items to carry in the haram:

- Dua books/iPhone
- Travel musallah
- Shoe bag
- Water bottle\spray bottle (comes in handy for doing wudhoo)
- No cameras allowed (hand bags are generally searched at the ladies' entrance especially in Madina)

Spiritual Packing:

"Patience, tolerance, forbearance, sharing, caring, forgiving, praying for others and being positive"

(Arafah/Muzdalifah/Mina)

- Backpack—supplied by the Group
- Set of Eham
- Travelling Mussala
- Prescription Medicine, share general medicine
- Torch (can be shared)
- Stone bags
- Dua books
- Spray bottle
- Some money for transportation and to buy tea & snacks
- Pair of scissors (for ladies can be shared)
- Men can use their eham pieces as a towel
- Change of clothes (One pair) for Men
- Small Towel for Ladies (to shower in Mina)
- Small supply of plastic shopping (grocery) bags
